Financial Support

Participants from the Freie Universität Berlin will receive financial support from the Ernst Reuter Gesellschaft and the Center for International Cooperation of the Freie Universität Berlin. The seminar will be partially funded by the aforementioned institutions.

Travel expenses

Travel expenses from Berlin to Cambridge will be refunded up to 215 EUR per person. These can include flight/train/bus travel tickets. Costs of traveling with a taxi will not be covered or reimbursed. For the reimbursement of travel expenses all tickets (plane, train, bus) and boarding passes must be submitted in original.

You will receive a reimbursement form and further information regarding the travel expenses by e-mail at the end of the seminar.

Accommodation expenses

Accommodation expenses will be reimbursed up to 135 EUR. Rooms for 2 nights (from Sunday 07.12.2014 to Tuesday 09.12.2014) have been pre-booked with special rates for this seminar. We have pre-booked rooms for 9 participants at the Jesus College Cambridge and 7 rooms at the Holiday Inn Express Hotel.

Jesus College Cambridge (located at the College Campus)

- single room for one person per night 69 GBP (about 86 EUR) breakfast included.

Holiday Inn Express (3.2 Km way from the venue location)

- single room for one person per night 122 EUR breakfast included.

Please notify us by email until 19.09.2014 whether you would like to take advantage of the reservation of one of these rooms. Rooms will be assigned in the order in which your emails are received. On September 23, 2014 you will receive an email with the confirmation. After expiry of the period mentioned above all remaining reserved rooms may be cancelled.

You can also look for accommodation yourself.

In any event, accommodation costs are to be paid on site by the participant. Participants will be reimbursed at the end of the seminar for accommodation costs for the sum of 135 EUR max. Please keep all the original invoices for reimbursement purposes.

Other (privately-held) costs

Joint dinner in Cambridge on Monday, December 8, 2014 at 7pm (probably with the Dinner speech) at the Campus: 28,40 GBP per Person.

Joint dinner in Berlin on Friday, December 12 at 7pm: about 30 EUR per person.

Travel

Participants will be responsible for organizing their travel arrangements, i.e. arranging their own travel tickets (flight, train, bus, etc...). Please book your tickets in advance in order to economize costs.

We strongly recommend participants from Berlin to travel on Sunday, December 7th. You can find economic tickets from 100 EUR to London with Easyjet, Ryanair, GermanWings and British Airways.

The nearest airport from the venue is Stansted (56km). Heathrow is approximately 128km away, and Gatwick 160km. Trains and National Express buses operate bus services between Cambridge and all three airports.

Participants can take a train from both London's Kings Cross Station and Liverpool Street Station to Cambridge. For further information on train services as well as train times and fares consult nationalrail.co.uk or thetrainline.com.

The College is located approximately 3.2 kilometers from the station. Busses need approximately 10 minutes from the station to the College, and there is a taxi rank outside the station. Taxis cost ca. 6 GBP.
