

## **Research Grants of the Funds David Constant**

**Faculty of Law and School of Criminology - University of Liege**

### **Statutes**

#### **Article 1**

Each year, the Funds David Constant offers research grants to a foreign researcher for scientific stay to the Liege Faculty of Law or School of criminology. The stay must be of three months minimum.

#### **Article 2**

The subject of the research must be law or criminology or in relation with law or criminology issues.

#### **Article 3**

The Faculty of Law constitutes a commission which will be charged to look into the candidatures and to make a proposal at the Funds David Constant, no later than May 20 (or the next working day). The commission can make a complementary statute.

#### **Article 4**

The scholarship award consists of 10.000 euros. It will be useful to cover subsistence and traveling expenses. The recipient will have to provide written proof of his costs at the end of the stay and will be held to refund, if necessary, the unused amount.

#### **Article 5**

The candidatures must be introduced to the Faculty with the adequate form, no later than May 2 or the next working day.

Researchers must proof that they will be welcomed in the service in which they wish to remain.

#### **Article 6**

The recipient of a scholarship of scientific stay must submit to the Funds David Constant, via Faculty, a report on the mission carried out. This report must be addressed no later than three months after the end of the stay.

Moreover, the foreign researcher who remains in ULg must produce a scientific contribution during his stay according to instructions with the professor who welcomed (publication in the review of Faculty, participation in a colloquium, conference...).
