Language Requirements	English proficiency is required
Application Procedure	Paper based. Students are sent the application forms as soon as the nomination is received and are required to provide a hard copy of the application
Application Deadline for both fall and spring semester	Fall semester – June 2017 Spring semester – November 2017
Semester Dates	Fall semester: October 22, 2017 – January 26, 2018 Students are able to leave the semester early (during the Christmas holiday time) in order to return to their home university  Spring semester: March 18, 2018 – June 28, 2018
Orientation Information	Orientation takes place the week before the start of the semester
Course Enrollment/Registration	Course information is emailed to students. Students may participate in courses offered at the Rothberg International School (please note that their semesters differ from the faculty of law's semester) Students may participate in the Hebrew Language Ulpan course. All course selections are sent to the coordinator, Shanie Rabinowitz.



	Students may add and drop courses during the first two weeks of the semester
Credit System	Students are advised to take between 11- 16 credits per semester.
On-campus Housing	<p>On-campus housing is guaranteed for all students who are interested.</p> <p>All students will be staying in the 'Student Village' dorms.</p> <p>Please note that the dorms do not supply pillows, blankets, towels, and kitchen utensils and household goods.</p> <p>More information can be found here: <a href="https://overseas.huji.ac.il/housing">https://overseas.huji.ac.il/housing</a></p>
Health Insurance Requirements	<p>Exchange students are required to have health insurance during their time abroad.</p> <p>Students may choose to keep their home health insurance or they may purchase health insurance provided by the Hebrew University.</p>
Visa Information	<p>Exchange students are required to visit their local Israeli Consulate or Embassy of Israel prior to their arrival to obtain a student visa.</p> <p>The student visa is an A2 visa – a multiple-entry student visa (making it possible to leave Israel for a vacation and return without requiring a new visa). The visa is valid for up to one year.</p> <p>Recipients of this visa are not permitted to work in Israel.</p> <p>It is mandatory that all students participating in programs of one semester or longer secure a Student Visa (A-2) before arriving in Israel.</p> <p>You must appear in person at the Israeli embassy or consulate to apply for a student visa. The following items must be submitted upon application:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Your passport or other travel document, valid for at least two years</li><li>• A letter of acceptance from the Hebrew University</li><li>• For students under age 18, a notarized declaration signed by both parents</li></ul>
