<b>Application Process</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Students must be nominated by the home university via our on-line form* (login details will be provided separately)</li> <li>2. If the nomination is in line with our exchange agreement, the students then receive a link to the on-line application form*</li> <li>3. Once students are accepted, they receive an email confirmation containing their applicant number. The applicant number allows students to apply for University accommodation</li> </ol> <p>* Note that our application process is electronic. We do not accept paper applications</p>
<b>Housing Information</b>	<p>Students can apply online for University owned accommodation once they have received their applicant number.
