<p>Application Process</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students must be nominated by the home university via our on-line form* (Information will be sent via email when nominations are open) 2. If the nomination is in line with our exchange agreement, the students then receive a link to the on-line application form* 3. Once students are accepted, they receive an email confirmation containing their applicant number. The applicant number allows students to apply for University accommodation <p>* Note that our application process is electronic. We do not accept paper applications</p>
<p>Module Choice Information</p>	<p>Module choice information will be emailed out to students with a link to online form to make their provisional choices – Incoming Law students are only permitted to take LAW modules within the School of Law (with the exception of English Language modules run by the ELTC)</p> <p>Students are required to study 60 Sheffield Credits (30 ECTS Credits) per semester.</p> <p>Students may be allowed to register for a minimum of 40 Sheffield Credits (20 ECTS Credits) for one semester or 100 Sheffield Credits for students studying with us for the full year (50 ECTS Credits)</p> <p>The students Home University must provide written authorisation for this.</p> <p>Students taking more than 60 UoS credits per semester will incur a charge for the additional credits.</p> <p>Choosing Postgraduate Modules</p> <p>Postgraduate modules are only suitable for students who have already completed 3 years or more of law study and whose level of English is fluent.</p> <p>This must be evidenced by providing transcripts to date and written approval from the Home University</p> <p>Please note that students who take postgraduate modules will not receive their results until April/May for Semester 1 and late July for Semester 2</p>
