<p><b>Insurance</b></p>	<p>European students must obtain a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). Non-European students must purchase a private health insurance.</p>
<p><b>Visa</b></p>	<p>Not required for citizens of the European Union. Students from non-EU countries must hold a visa valid for the duration of their stay, to do so contact the Portuguese Embassy or Consulate in your home country.</p>
