We are looking for high performing, established academics to join our prestigious and highly-competitive Essex International Visiting Fellowships programme.

This flagship programme provides support for outstanding researchers to undertake research at the University of Essex, which is of major importance in its field and of significant benefit to Essex's research.

The programme provides a competitive platform to:

- champion Essex as a centre of scholarly excellence at an international level
- raise the profile of the multi-disciplinary research community at Essex
- engage with external experts
- enrich the research and training environment for early career postgraduate and post-doctoral scholars at Essex

Programme components

The Essex International Visiting Fellowship programme has two components:

1) Short-Stay International Visiting Fellowship – for leading, international senior researchers to spend 14 days at Essex

Call 1 2018/19

For visiting Fellowships between September-December 2018
Deadline: 31 July 2018

Call 2 2018/19

For visiting Fellowships between January-April 2019
Deadline: 30 November 2018

Call 3 2018/19

For visiting Fellowships between May-July 2019
Deadline: 31 March 2019

2) Extended International Visiting Fellowship – for leading, international senior researchers to spend a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 10 months at Essex starting in September 2018

Deadline: 31 July 2018

The University of Essex will provide International Visiting Fellows with:

- status of a University International Visiting Fellow
- return economy airfare to/from the UK
- exclusive use of a University owned house within walking distance of Colchester Campus*
- small weekly stipend

*Southend and Loughton based fellows will be accommodated in local B&B Hotel

Eligibility

Essex International Visiting Fellowships are open to all academics, based outside the United Kingdom, who have a sustained track record of significant output, as demonstrated in peer-reviewed literature, and a strong commitment to quality research outputs as judged relative to opportunity.
