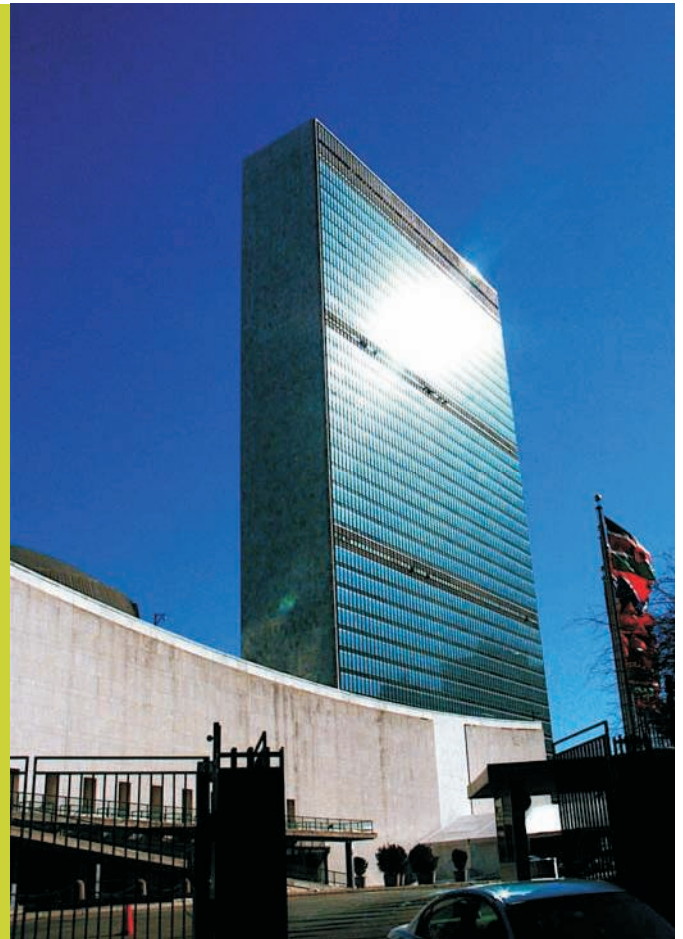

# The Responsibility to Protect The Case of Syria

Berlin, 26 September 2012



The situation in **Libya** stirred up the ongoing debate on the so called concept of **Responsibility to Protect**.

The debate showed that around the concept many questions arise: In which cases does it apply? Which are the appropriate measures to be taken? Under which circumstances is a military intervention authorized by the Security Council legitimate?

And finally: Why has there not been action on the situation in **Syria**?
