

Directions to the Law Department of Freie Universität Berlin

Our university is located in the south-west of Berlin (district: Dahlem). The closest metro stop to our Law Department is "Freie Universität Berlin-Thielplatz" (line U₃).

Please note that you will need considerable time to get here when you use public transport.

Depending on where you start, it will take you between 30 minutes (city center West) and 60 minutes (city center East).

If you wish to plan your trip in advance, you can use the journey planner on the following web site: http://www.bvg.de/index.php/en/index.html. You will also find a network map on this site.

When you get out of the train at the metro station "Freie Universität-Thielplatz", please use the exit that is in the same direction as the train was going. After the stairs, turn to the left and cross the street Brümmerstraße at the traffic light. After the traffic light, please turn to the right and follow Brümmerstraße until you see the sign for Van't-Hoff-Straße. Then turn to the left into Van't-Hoff-Straße.

Please walk about 100 meters along Van't-Hoff-Straße (over the parking lot). There you will find this building. Please enter and enjoy the Seminar.
