ACAI	DEMIC INFORMATIONS
Academic year	The academic year is divided into two semesters, autumn and spring, each semester lasting thirteen weeks. <u>Semester 1</u> : 3 rd of September – 11 th of January <u>Semester 2</u> : 12 th of January – 30 th of June
Expected date of arrival	It is recommended that students arrive in time to attend the orientation days or at the latest a few days prior to the beginning of the semester. The semester begins at the same time for all faculties.
Transcript of records	Exchange students get a copy of their transcript of academic records at the end of their stay. The transcript is sent directly to the home university approx. 2 weeks after final exams. (by scan or paper)
Credits and grading system	60 ECTS credits amounts to full time studies for one academic year and 30 ECTS credits are considered full time studies per semester.

Courses offered for exchange students	Course selection must consist of 30 ECTS credits per semester, where at least 60% of courses are within students major.
