If you're considering Essex then I say "just go for it!"

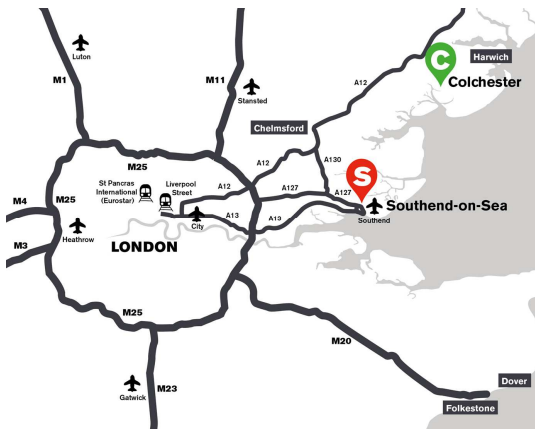

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Academic requirements:

- Students must be in good academic standing
- Gap year applicants must have finished high school education before enrolling

English language requirements:

- IELTS 6.0 or
- TOEFL iBT 76

EXCHANGE STUDENTS

You could be eligible to apply for our student exchange programme if your university has an exchange or Erasmus+ agreement with Essex. Exchange and Erasmus+ students do not pay tuition fees for their Study Abroad period.
