<b>Language requirements</b>	JKU requires proof of language proficiency in German and/or English (level B2 or higher of the <a href="#">Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)</a> ).  <b>We accept the following certification:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ All internationally recognized language certificates such as TOEFL, Goethe etc.</li> <li>■ English or German courses at the required level (B2) as noted in student's Transcript of Records</li> <li>■ Confirmation issued by home university in regards to student's language skills (German OR English) at the required level B2</li> </ul>
<b>Workload</b>	A full workload corresponds to 30 ECTS credits per semester.  Exchange students are expected to take a minimum workload of 20 ECTS credits per semester.
<b>Transcript of records</b>	The Transcript of Records is signed with an official electronic signature and can be downloaded by the students directly from our Kepler University Study Support System.
