- Access to the College of Law's facilities and a semi-private work space with a desk and access to printer capabilities within the building.
- Opportunities to present research to the College of Law community through our International Workshop Program.
- English language classes are available on campus.

Costs

Scholars must be self-funded to support their cost of living and the program fee. The fee is approximately \$5,000 per semester or \$10,000 per calendar year. Partial scholarships are available. Applications are accepted year-round. Visit our website for more information.
