**T**he Visiting Scholars Program at Illinois provides an opportunity for qualified individuals to conduct independent research in a law school setting. Visits can be for any duration although a minimum of four months is recommended. Ideal candidates are **judges, faculty, advanced students, and practitioners.**

### Benefits

- Each scholar is provided a faculty host and an opportunity to audit law courses.
- Access to library and research tools (including unlimited LexisNexis, Westlaw, and Bloomberg databases).
- Access to the College of Law's facilities and a semi-private work space with a desk and access to printer capabilities within the building.
- Opportunities to present research to the College of Law community through our International Workshop Program.
- English language classes are available on campus.

### Costs

**Scholars must be self-funded to support their cost of living and the program fee.** The fee is approximately \$5,000 per semester or \$10,000 per calendar year. Partial scholarships are available. Applications are accepted year-round. Visit our website for more information.
